In partnership with the Community Foundation of the Virgin Islands (CFVI), we are delighted to offer to you the updated 2011-2013 Directory of Community Organizations dedicated to improving the quality of life here in the U.S. Virgin Islands. This directory was first created in 2004 because of our own experience when we relocated to St. Thomas. We determined that a directory of community organizations would be a useful resource to U.S. Virgin Islanders.

The professional staff of CFVI informed us that any initiative to strengthen the non-profit sector would have a great impact on the entire community. Whether you are a working parent searching for a quality summer program, a counselor looking for a legal advocate for an abused child or a volunteer wanting to do community service, we hope you find what you are looking for in this directory.

Thank you to everyone who contributed to the creation and revision of this directory. Together, we can effect real change and improve the quality of life here in the U.S. Virgin Islands.

About The South Bay Partners Fund

The South Bay Partners Fund was established in 2003 by community members Bart Kavanaugh and Betty Saks through the Community Foundation of the Virgin Islands (CFVI) with the purpose of strengthening the non-profit community in the territory and promoting philanthropy in the U.S. Virgin Islands.

With professional guidance from CFVI, the South Bay Partners Fund launched an initiative to strengthen the non-profit sector in the territory. This is a multi-phase project that began with conducting needs assessment research. A survey was designed to gather basic contact information, leadership profiles, financial data, organizational structure, purpose and developmental needs of non-profit organizations.

Agency leaders who completed a survey were then invited to attend focus groups to engage in a dialogue about both their organizational and professional needs. Non-profit agency leaders expressed that there is a real need for a directory of non-profit organizations to be made available to the profession for referrals and networking, and to the public to increase awareness of services available. This directory is a product of the South Bay Partners Fund, through the Community Foundation of the Virgin Islands.

As a service to their donors, CFVI is available to provide comprehensive organizational profiles of community non-profits to effectively guide philanthropic giving. CFVI is committed to connecting donors with identified community needs.

In addition to its work with the non-profit community, the South Bay Partners Fund is committed to improving the early childhood environment in the U.S. Virgin Islands, particularly as it impacts low wage-earning families. With assistance from the South Bay Partners Fund and other donors, CFVI conducted a study of the early child care field in the territory and determined that the best first-step to benefit the greatest number of children would be to establish a center for child care resources and professional development (The Family Connection Center). Designed to provide training programs, networking and resource tools to the territory's hard-working child care providers and early education professionals – as well as to the parents of young children – the mission of The Family Connection Center is to strengthen the community child care and early education infrastructure in the U.S. Virgin Islands.
