



2012 CFVI GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS

CFVI has the following Graduate Scholarships available for 2012 for which you may be eligible.

CAHS Alumni Physician Scholarship - Provides a merit based educational scholarship in the amount of \$5,000 per year for four years to a CAHS graduate that has been accepted to an accredited United States medical school. In order to be considered for or maintain this scholarship the candidate must have attended CAHS for a minimum of three years, be a US Virgin Islands resident for 5 years, and the medical student must remain in good academic standing throughout the process of matriculation.

Cynthia de Haynes Health Science Scholarship – Provides a scholarship in the amount of \$3,000 for one year to a resident that has completed his/her undergraduate degree with a 2.5 or greater GPA and is enrolled in or has been accepted to an accredited college or university to study Alternative Medicine, Pharmacy or Nursing.

NSL Graduate Studies Scholarship Fund – Provides a scholarship in the amount of \$2,000 for one year to a resident currently enrolled or that has applied to an accredited graduate program for studies in Humanities, Social Sciences or Fine Arts. Applicant must be a US Virgin Islands resident for 5 years with a GPA of 2.5 or greater.

To apply for any of the above please submit the following:

- ✓ A 1-2 page letter describing your interest, career goals, and field of study.
- ✓ A resume describing your educational (high school and college) and work history and including your address, telephone number, cell phone number, email address and student ID if available.
- ✓ The acceptance letter from the school at which you are or will be enrolled.
- ✓ A copy of your financial aid letter with a statement of how much you and/or your family expect to contribute and/or borrow for your education. If you are not taking out a loan, please include a note to that effect.
- ✓ Two letters of recommendation pertinent to the scholarship applied for, preferably one from your employer or supervisor, and one from an academic advisor or instructor. The letters must be current (2011), on official letterhead, contain your first and last name, and signed by the writer, who must identify his/her relationship to you (not a family member). E-mail letters are not acceptable.
- ✓ A copy of the first two pages of your most recently filed federal income tax form.
- ✓ A copy of your most recent academic transcript. A printout from the internet is not acceptable.
