V.I. 100 CLUB at the

Donates \$3,000 to Fallen Officer's Family

On Friday, February 9th, The **V.I. 100 Club** at the Community Foundation of the Virgin Islands (CFVI) presented a check for \$3,000 to acting Police Commissioner James McCall. The donation is for the family of Officer Ariel Frett, who was killed on Thursday, to acknowledge the community's deep appreciation to Officer Frett and to assist the family with expenses related to his untimely death.

The VI 100 Club is a special fund at CFVI, which is composed of a group of individuals on the islands committed to keeping our community a safe place to live and to support those officers who protect it. Donations to the fund are used to purchase life protecting equipment for the VI Police Department that cannot be secured through budgeted funds, provide officer recognition and educational opportunities, and aid dependents of police officers who lose their lives in the line of duty.
